

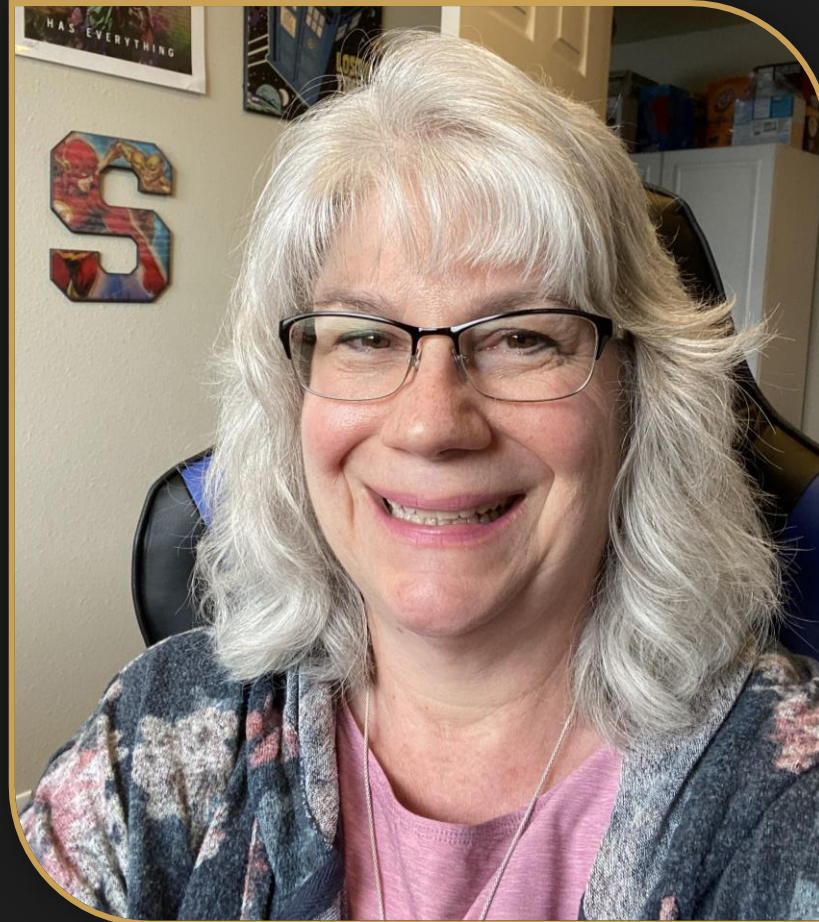
To the Lapwai Community: I have enjoyed feeding and watching your children grow. I will forever have a long relationship with my kids.
