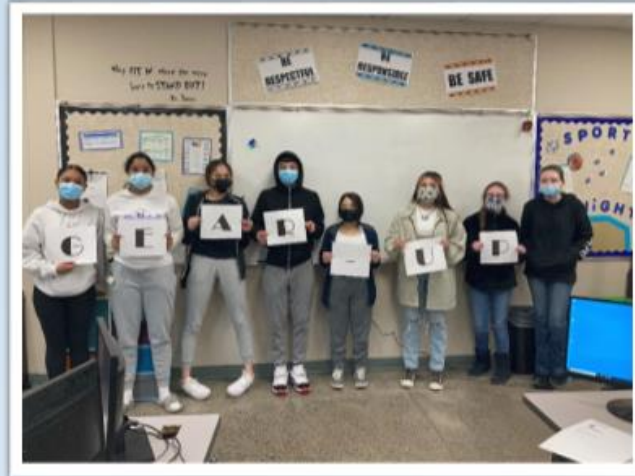


Gaining Early Awareness & Readiness for Undergraduate Programs

Gear Up is a state grant designed to prepare students to enter and succeed in post-secondary education. This includes Associate and Bachelor's Degree, Professional/Technical Certifications and Apprenticeships.

GEAR UP provides services starting in the 7th grade and through graduation. Services focus on career exploration, college visits, financial literacy, STEM activities, life skills, tutoring, academic rigor, tuition and scholarships.

ALL Gear Up students are eligible to receive program scholarships if specific requirements are met.

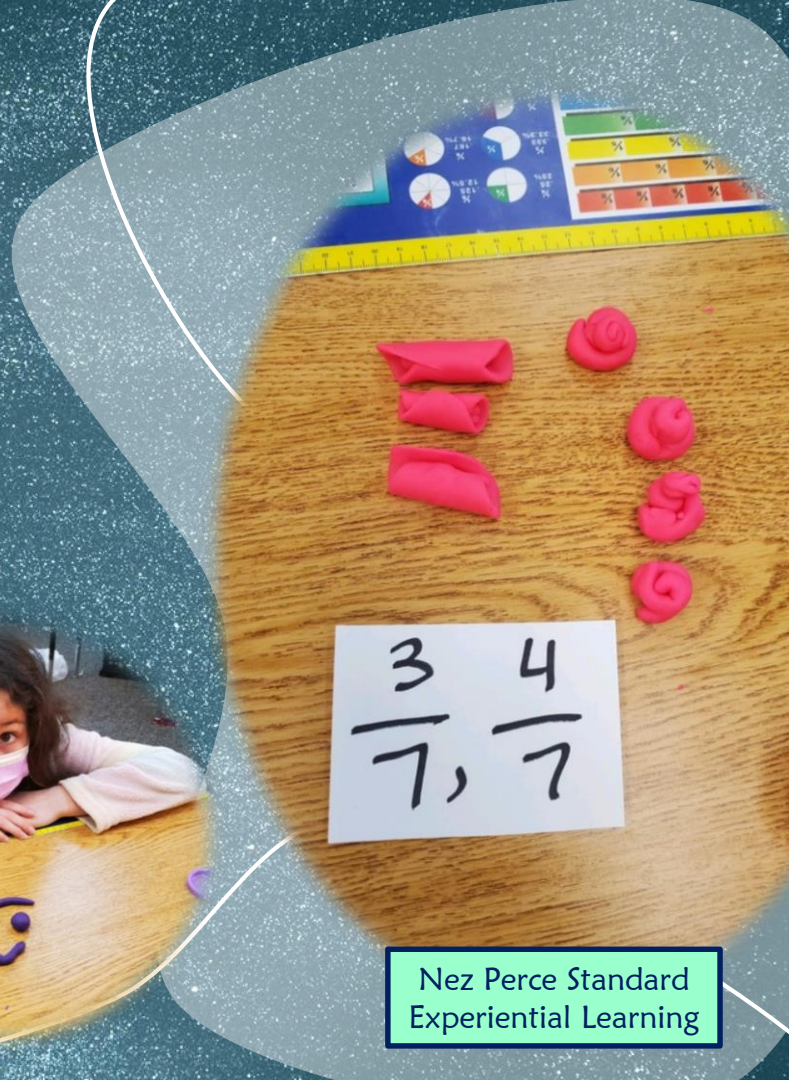
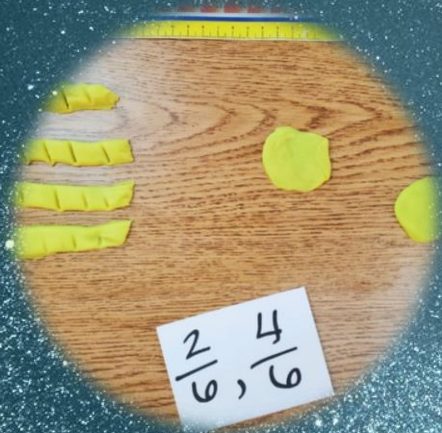
