


College & Career Readiness

The Lapwai School District was awarded the funds to build a new Career and Technical Education Center at Lapwai Middle-High School. Please join us in celebrating the Nez Perce Tribe for their support as industry partners through the funding process! The award included \$1,278,843 in Idaho Career Ready Student Funds, a \$51,000 material donation from R & M Steel in Caldwell, Idaho, and \$20,000 in Nez Perce Tribe Local Education Program Funds. The design-build team selected was Castellaw Kom Architects and Arnzen Building Construction. The facility will expand carpentry and fabrication instruction with a long-term goal of automotive technology. Welding will remain in the current agricultural building behind the high school. The next phase includes finalizing the design, yet initial draft concept proposals are exciting.



Safety First!



The Lapwai School District was also awarded an Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) grant to improve intercom systems and other safety enhancements districtwide. The enhancements include:

Two-way intercom communication

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- > The ability to call individual classrooms
- Lanyards with microphones, enabling teachers to amplify their voice over the same speakers in their classrooms
- > The lanyards include panic buttons to notify the office discreetly in the event of an emergency
- Cameras in every instructional space
- > In the event of an emergency, we can provide first responders immediate video access

This will accompany other recently installed security features. Perimeters will remain locked the majority of the school day. Guests are requested to use video intercoms at entrances for school entry. Similar to a door bell, our offices are alerted of your arrival. We welcome visitors with the two-way intercom and open the door remotely.


