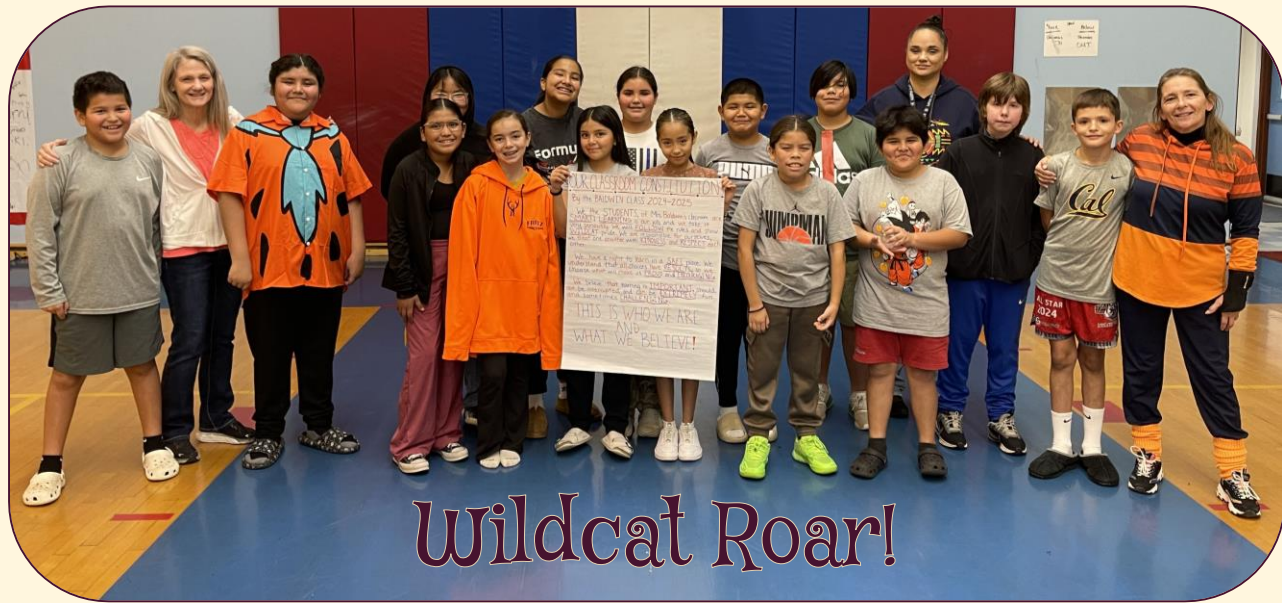

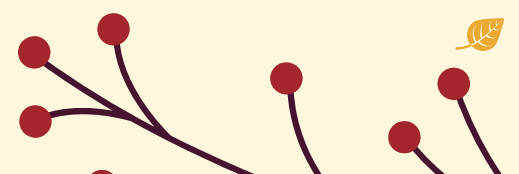


Wildcat Roar!

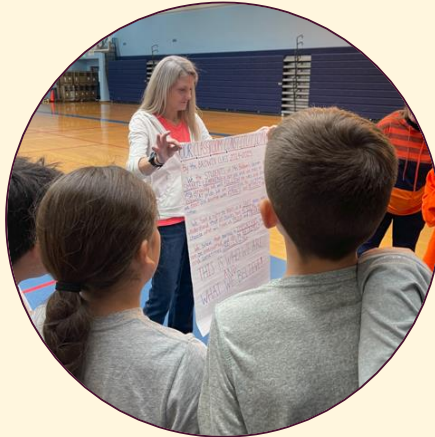

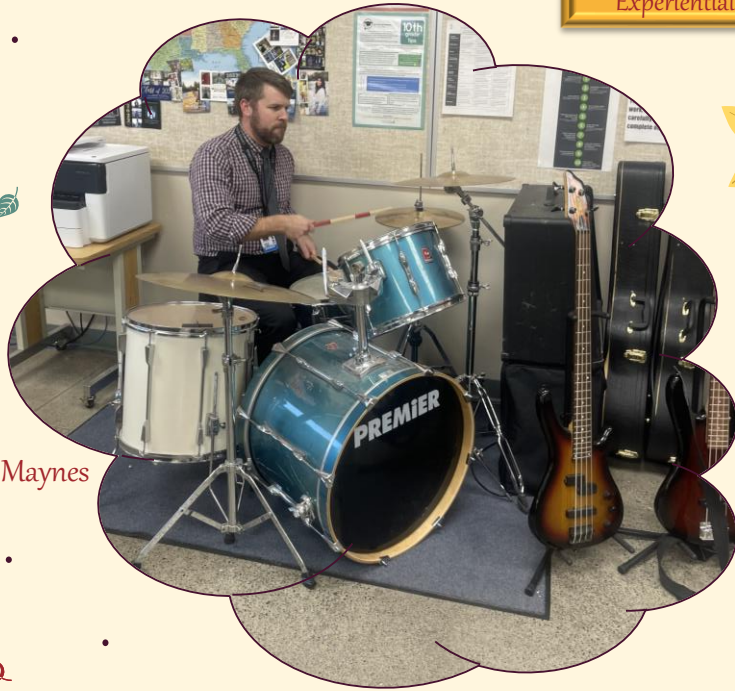

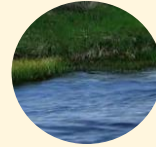
