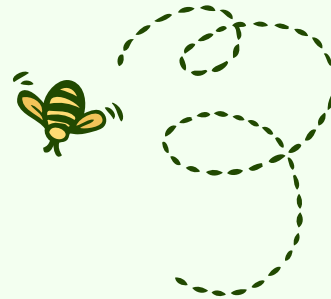
Wildcat Roar!
